## T8 Airport Line Power Supply Upgrade Project



### What's the latest news?

During December, the project team carried out drilling for geotechnical, survey, and potholing investigations on Wyndham Street between Mandible Street and Bourke Street.

### What's planned next?

During February, the project team will be carrying out the following work:

- delivery of a generator on an oversize vehicle
- installation of cables to service the Rail Operations Centre on Wyndham Street near Mandible Street.

### Are there activities planned out of hours?

Some out of hours work is planned to safely complete the required work:

- 6am, Saturday 27 to 6pm, Sunday 28 February.

The project team understands construction activities may cause disruption for the community. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts where possible such as traffic control and signage for vehicles and cyclists travelling near site investigation locations. We will also ensure we adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

These works are dependent on weather and site conditions and are subject to change.
