

Transport Access Program Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification February 2023

Transport for NSW is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.



Coloured concrete footpaths have been poured and new lighting has started being installed on Berkeley Road West.

Completed work

Traffic flow was changed in Berkeley Road West Loop Road in January.

The lift shaft on the Berkeley Road West side had glass installed, and the canopy over the new stairs was installed. Fencing went in on the retaining wall along the rail corridor and more coloured concrete footpaths were poured to access the new stairs and lifts.

Lighting was installed at the station entrance and in the plaza on the Berkeley Road East side of the station.

Upcoming work

Footpath work, lighting and landscaping will continue on the Berkeley Road East side.

On the Berkeley Road West side, stormwater work will continue in the commuter carpark and fencing will continue to be installed on the retaining wall along the rail corridor. Lift installation will begin, roofing will start above the stairs and the awning will go on at the lift entry. Road upgrades will also start.

Regrading work will be done at the southern end of the platform and preparations for stormwater work will start at the northern end.

Out-of-hours work

Out-of-hours work will be carried out between **6pm Friday 3 March and 12 midnight Sunday 5 March**. For the safety of staff and customers this will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

Work to be completed this weekend includes:

- craning in and installing the bridge planks between lifts
- craning in and installing the pre-built stair canopies on the platform
- installing the screens on the bridge between lifts.

Equipment being used includes multiple cranes, excavator, tipper truck, rail vehicles, height access equipment and hand tools.

This work may generate higher than normal levels of noise. Once noise assessments have been carried out, respite vouchers may be offered to residents immediately surrounding the out-of-hours working areas. Wherever possible, we will take measures to reduce noise including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, exercising respite periods during work, and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Working hours

Aside from weekend work mentioned above, normal working hours will continue to be carried out between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm Saturdays**. Some work may also be carried out on weekends until the end of the project, from **7am to 6pm Saturdays** and **8am to 6pm Sundays**.

Commuter car park and loop road

The commuter car park will be closed from **6pm Thursday 2 March until 6am Tuesday 7 March** to allow cranes to be set up. Alternate parking will be available in the Wollongong council car park on Central Road.

The loop road from Princes Highway to the commuter car park will be closed from **6pm Friday 3 March until 6am Monday 6 March**. There will be traffic control in place.
