



Unanderra Station Upgrade is complete

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wodi Wodi people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government has upgraded accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade was delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

Completed work

We are pleased to announce the accessibility upgrade at Unanderra Station is complete.

As well as improving safety and access, we are honoured to have consulted with Coomaditchie United Aboriginal Corporation and local designers to include beautiful architectural and landscape designs.

These partnerships allowed us to use design elements to weave Aboriginal narratives and themes throughout the station to provide an enriching experience for commuters, connecting them to the natural environment. These included:

- intricate design patterns on the lift shafts and footbridge reflecting the faulting and joint work of the sandstone cliffs and escarpment west of the station
- architectural elements at the station entrances and plaza area incorporating local flora, fauna and geology

- dark strips running down the side of the lift shafts, mimicking waterfall features
- footpaths featuring sandblasted Aboriginal artworks resembling Aboriginal meeting places, family, and closeness. The paths have been treated and sandblasted, and the concrete has been coloured with patterns and designs
- sandstone blocks which were sourced locally and feature a Welcome to Dharawal Country.

What we delivered

The accessibility upgrade includes:

- a new footbridge and stairs with canopies
- three new lifts providing accessible cross corridor and platform access
- new kiss and ride zones, accessible parking spaces and bus zones on Berkeley Road (east and west) including seating and improved access paths
- upgraded station entrances with new pavements, pathways and landscaping
- platform modifications, including new boarding assistance zones
- updated station building with new family accessible toilet and ambulant toilet
- upgraded power services and communications room
- Additional station lighting and closed-circuit television (CCTV).
