## Unanderra Station Upgrade

Community notification April 2023

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Unanderra Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

### Completed work

During the weekend of 3 to 5 March, the station was transformed when the footbridge and canopies were installed. This milestone was achieved with the coordination of many contractors and two very large cranes, to install the bridge planks between the new lift and the pre-built canopies and screens on the bridge. The weekend work was a success, and all planned work was completed.

### Upcoming work

In the next month, work will continue on both sides of the station with footpaths and ramps being poured, and landscaping work to continue. Fences and a bus shelter will be installed on the Berkeley Road West side of the station. On the platform, some work will be done to regrade the platform surface and tactiles will be installed.

Handrails around the stairs will start to be installed, the new lifts will have door jams fitted. Some electrical work will be done in the bridge canopies.

## Working hours

Normal working hours will continue between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm Saturdays**. Some work may also be carried out on weekends until the end of the project, from **7am to 6pm Saturdays** and **8am to 6pm Sundays**.

## Commuter carpark and loop road

The commuter car park will continue to have some spaces unavailable while the landscaping, footpaths and kerbs are built. Alternate parking will be available in the Wollongong council car park on Central Road.
