# **Petersham Station footbridge works**

# From Saturday 15 July to Sunday 16 July 2023

### What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance work at Petersham Station from Saturday 15 July to Sunday 16 July to protect the footbridge steelwork from corrosion and extend the life of the structure.

Work activities include abrasive blasting and repainting a section of the footbridge.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

## How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works will create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place from 5am Saturday 15 July to 11pm Sunday 16 July.
- Work activities will include abrasive blasting, vacuum cleaning, and compressors. We will select low-noise compressors and equipment, where low-noise alternatives are available.
- Material and equipment will be delivered with flatbed trucks based on Terminus Street, which will be idling for extended periods.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

#### Footbridge closure

- The footbridge at Petersham Station will be closed from 2am Saturday 15 July to 11pm Sunday 16 July.
- Pedestrians will be able to cross the rail corridor via the Petersham Station subway tunnel.

#### **Traffic and Parking**

- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.


