What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the existing footbridge at Mount Colah Station. As part of the project, new lifts will also be constructed on the platform's eastern and western sides of the station.

To prepare for the construction of a new pedestrian footbridge and lifts, we will be carrying out civil works around the station from Monday 15 January to Friday 16 February.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise.
- Works will take place from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
- Power tools and machinery will be used throughout work, and we will select low-noise equipment where possible.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Street parking closures

- We will require some parking spots on Pierre Close, Mount Colah from 7am Monday 15 January to 6pm
 Friday 16 February.
- Parking will be available in other areas along Pierre Close, Mount Colah.
- Access to driveways will always be maintained.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to direct motorists and pedestrians throughout the works.


