


Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

May and June 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building a new substation within the rail corridor to create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport Line in the future. This notification outlines what work we will be carrying out in May and June 2023.

What work are we doing?

In May and June 2023 we will undertake the following activities:

- continuing to fit out the substation and installing a new fence around the boundary
- installing cables, metal fixings and other electrical infrastructure to connect power from the substation to the track
- modifications to the rail corridor boundary fence near Spark Lane.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

Due to safety reasons some work will take place outside of standard construction hours from:

- 6am to 6pm on Saturday 13 May and Sunday
 14 May 2023
- 6am to 6pm on Saturday 24 June and Sunday 25 June 2023.

We'll be working inside the rail corridor and within the site compounds located at 5A and 25 Lusty Street. The map overleaf outlines locations of the work and site access points.

We are going paperless



This is the last paper notification you will receive from us.

We are committed to reducing our paper usage and environmental impacts.

After May 2023, we will no longer be distributing paper notifications to residents (unless requested). Instead, we will contact you via email when there is construction work that may impact you.

Out-of-hours deliveries

In connection to the work, there may be several out-of-hours deliveries made to the site compound on Lusty Street and Henderson Street from 6pm Monday 19 June to 6am Friday 30 June 2023.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- · workers and heavy vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Additionally, up to ten parking spaces will be temporarily removed on Henderson Street, Turrella from 8am Monday 19 June to 6am Friday 30 June (see map below). Signage will be in place to notify road users and commuters.
