We would like to acknowledge the support from the Sydney Trains crew, maintenance team and the planning team for the timetable adjustments and the dedicated volunteers from Historic Electric Traction who assisted with the event on the day.

What work are we doing?

We will continue with minor finishing works in **October 2023**. This includes:

- installing signage throughout the station
- carrying out patching, painting, concrete repairs, steel welding and other related tasks on the lifts, the station master's office, concourse and platform buildings.

When we'll be working

Our normal work hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

We will also work from **4am Saturday 28 October** until **12am Monday 30 October** during scheduled Sydney Train trackwork.



What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles around the station
- traffic controllers, temporary lane closures and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment

During the Sydney Train trackwork, a train replacement bus service will be available and there will be a temporary closure to Kinson Crescent car park.

Managing our impacts

We will do everything we can to avoid disruption while we work and will put measures in place to reduce the disturbance to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- fencing for safety and security
- reducing noise as much as possible
- traffic controllers and signage
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill.
