What we're doing

Sydney Trains will be removing an overhead wire weight system near Railway Crescent cross John Street, Burwood from Saturday 20 April to Sunday 21 April.

A crane and elevated work platform will be in use to disconnect and lower the weight set safely onto a truck at Railway Crescent.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend.
- Work will take place from 6am Saturday 20 April to 6pm Sunday 21 April.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times.
- A crane, elevated work platform machine and trucks will be in operation.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Road closure and traffic

- A road closure will be in place for Railway Crescent, between Burwood Road and Park Road from 6am to 6pm Saturday 20 April and 6am to 6pm Sunday 21 April. A detour via George Street will be in place. Traffic controllers will assist motorists and pedestrians.
- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets on and near Railway Crescent.
- Please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near work site.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
