

Slope remediation work on Hawkesbury Road, Hawkesbury Heights from Monday 20 May

Community Notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug Peoples of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present people of the Hawkesbury.

Transport for NSW's road maintenance service provider for Western Sydney, Ventia, is undertaking planned remediation of three slopes on Hawkesbury Road, less than one kilometre west from Roberts Parade at Hawkesbury Heights.

This work will stabilise slopes damaged by a flooding event in 2022.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- establishing a small stockpile area and site office on Hawkesbury Road, using an existing cleared space in the road reserve opposite Hawkesbury Lookout
- creating temporary parking areas
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- installing safety barriers where work areas are within three metres of live traffic
- clearing vegetation and trees where needed
- scaling work and removing loose rocks
- drilling and installing long rock bolts, securing the outer rock face to underlying material.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at these slopes for 11 weeks from **Monday 20 May to Friday 2 August 2024**, weather and ground conditions permitting.

Standard working hours will be **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays.

We will also need carry out some work at night to safely transport large plant to and from site and minimise traffic disruption on Hawkesbury Road. **We will notify the community ahead of any nightwork taking place.**

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- lane closures and traffic control signage
- traffic controllers to guide heavy vehicle access on and off site when needed.

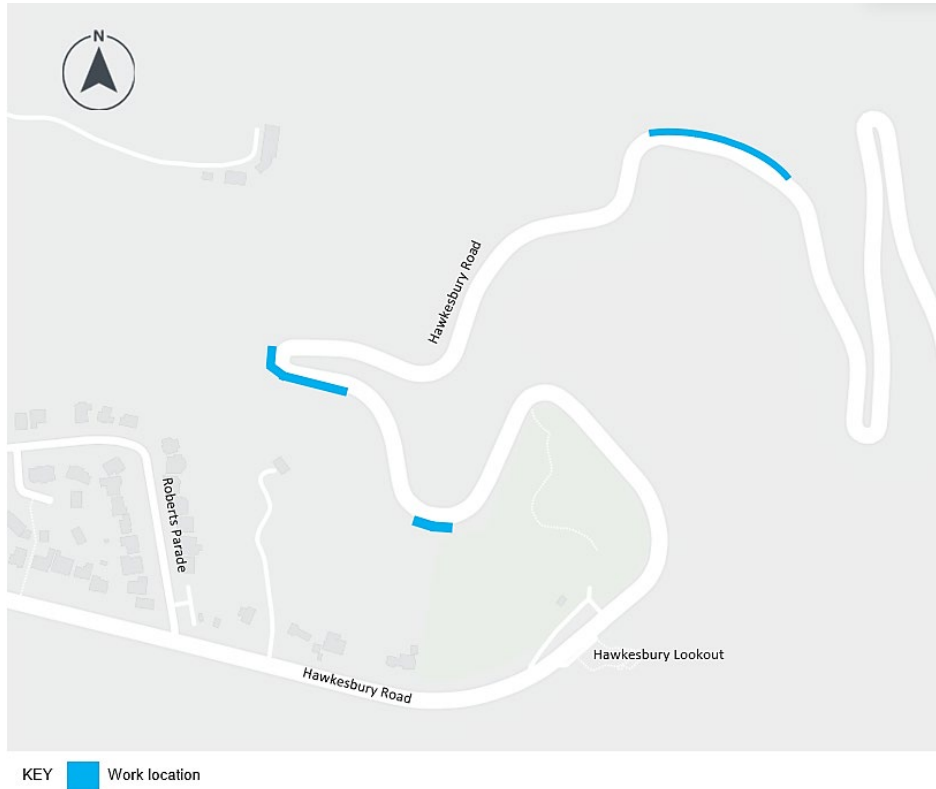
Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment, including:

- fencing for safety and security
- separating vehicle and pedestrian access
- protecting trees with no-go areas
- erosion and sediment controls
- targeting lighting to minimise light spill
- using a designated wash-out area for concrete trucks, and taking excess material away
- replanting trees at an appropriate location to replace those removed (in accordance with the landscaping plan)
- turning off machines when not in use.

Traffic impacts

Hawkesbury Road will remain open while we work. However, there will be, lane closures, contraflow and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h for the safety of our workers and road users. Signs will inform people of truck movements.

Normal traffic flow will resume when crews are not working. Cyclists may find this section of road slower to climb than usual.

Lane closures and operation of a contraflow during working hours may result in traffic delays. **Please allow an additional 10 minutes for travel.**
