What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance work at Homebush from Saturday 6 April 2024 to Monday 8 April.

To improve service reliability and reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we're undertaking turnout renewal works.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from 2am Saturday 6 April to 2am Monday 8 April.**
- Equipment and materials may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets including to access parts of the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that some on-street parking will be unavailable along The Crescent during the work. See map on next page for details.
- **A section of The Crescent near the corner of Homebush Road will be heavily congested on Saturday 6 April and Sunday 7 April due to a high volume of plant movements into and out of the site.**
- Traffic controllers will be on duty at The Crescent near Homebush Road to direct pedestrians and motorists throughout the duration of the works.

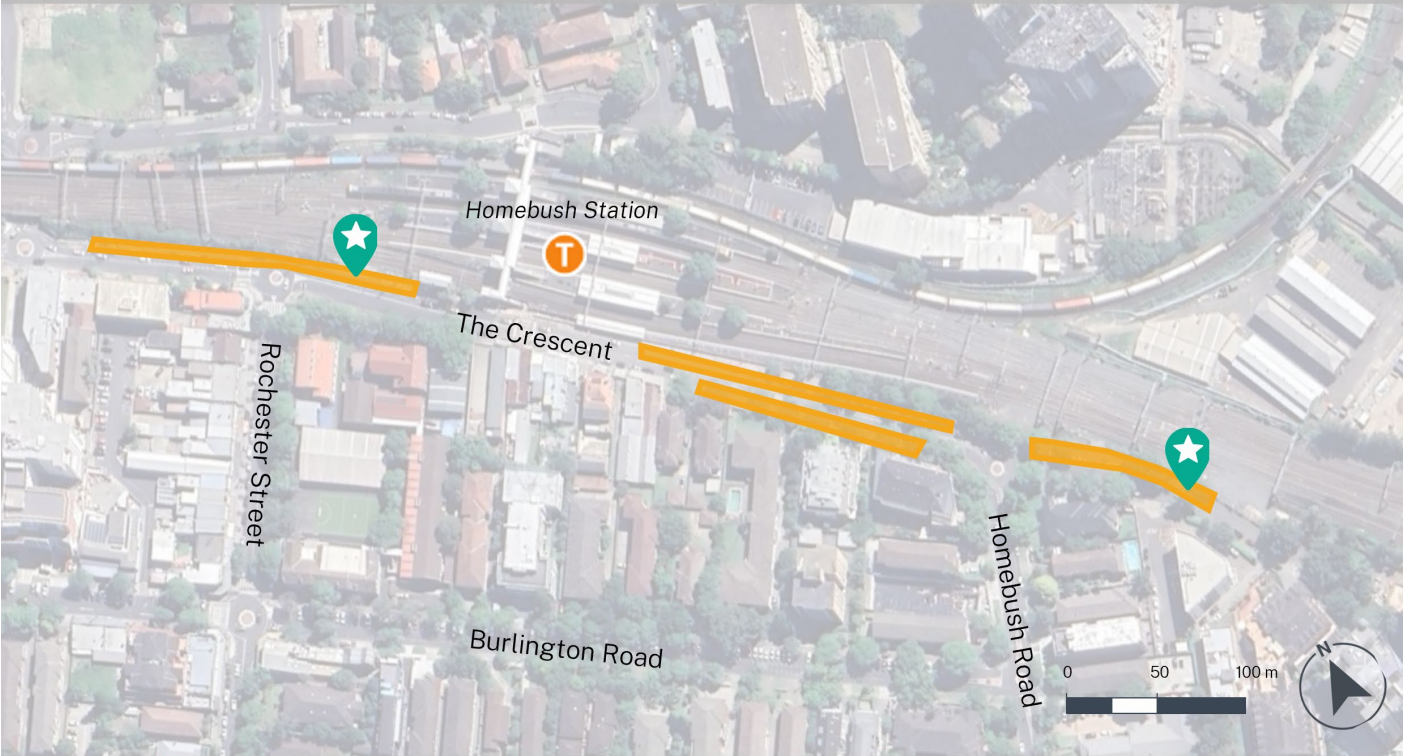
