What we're doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains will complete the construction of a retaining wall along the embankment adjacent to the track, about 1km west of Leura Station, from Saturday 16 March to Friday 19 April.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from**
 - **6am to 6pm Saturday 16 March and Sunday 17 March**
 - **6.30am to 5pm Monday to Friday**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Work vehicles will access the rail corridor via a gate on Railway Parade.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.

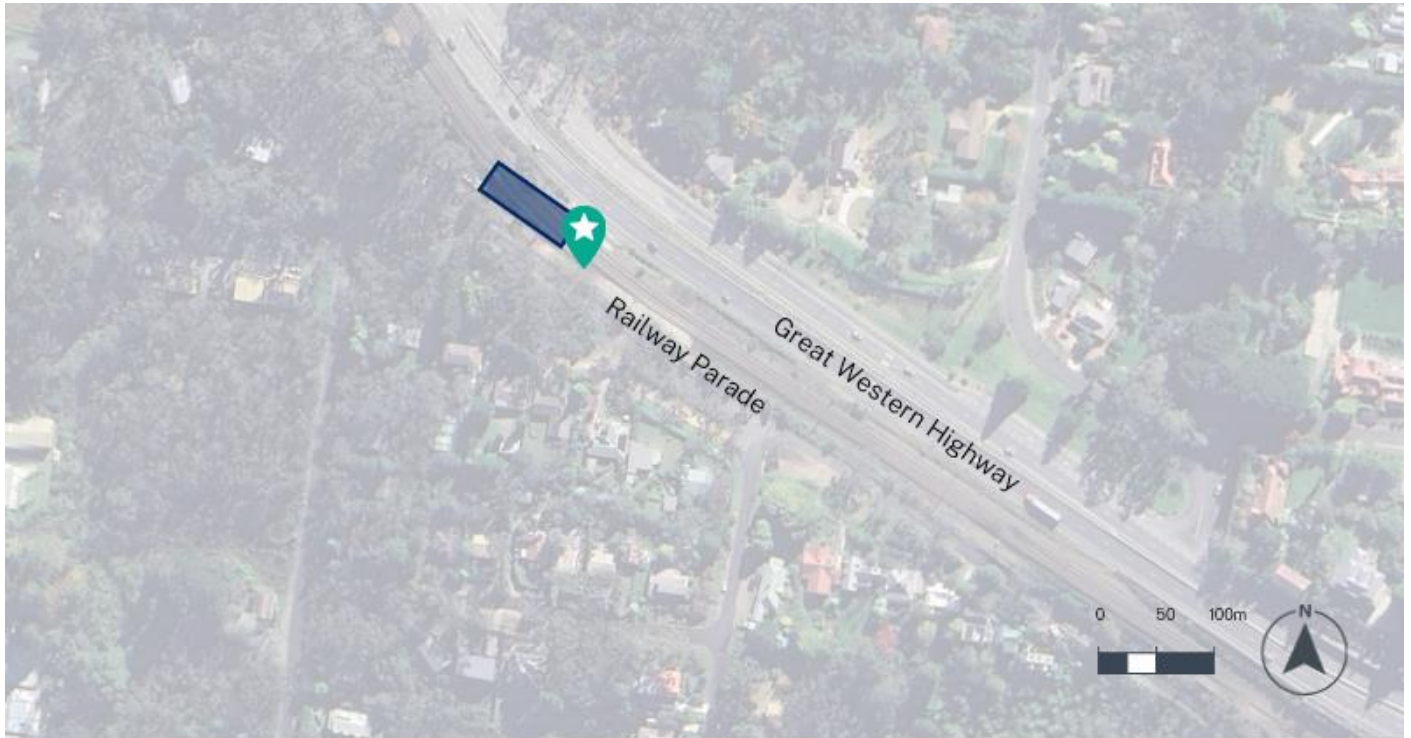
