What we're doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains will be constructing new overhead wiring and remove existing overhead wiring structures in the rail corridor between Lavender Bay Station and Lavender Bay tunnel from Monday 17 June to Friday 28 June 2024.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from 6am to 6pm Monday 17 June to Friday 28 June.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
