



Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

More Trains, More Services

March and April 2024



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal Clans as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building a new substation within the rail corridor to create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport Line in the future.

What work are we doing?

In March and April we will:

- carry out electrical work inside the substation. This includes testing and commissioning electrical infrastructure for operational use in the future
- modify and test electrical infrastructure and cables near Wolli Creek Station
- remove temporary fencing near Spark Lane.

When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am and 1pm on Saturdays**.

We'll be working inside the rail corridor and in the site compounds at 5A and 25 Lusty Street.

Out-of-hours work and deliveries

There will be workers removing temporary fencing near Spark Lane between **10pm and 4am from Sunday 3 March to Saturday 9 March 2024**. During this period workers are expected to produce minimal noise but you may temporary lighting towers. Every effort will be made to direct the light away from apartment buildings.

Furthermore, some work and deliveries will take place outside of standard construction hours when no trains are running from **6pm Friday 5 April to 8am Monday 8 April 2024**.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- an increase in workers and vehicles
- temporary lighting towers
- traffic controllers
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand our work may cause disruption for the community. We'll seek to minimise impacts as much as possible and follow strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.
