The NSW Government is upgrading 3.6 kilometres of Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future traffic demands on this corridor.

What work are we doing?

- excavation and pavement demolition (includes hammering)
- drainage and utility works
- placement of materials
- pavement construction
- kerb and gutter installation
- line marking and barrier installation

When and where we'll be working

We will carry out pavement works at the intersection of St Martins Crescent and Prospect Highway on the following dates, weather permitting:

- **8pm Friday 3 May to 5am Monday 6 May**
- **8pm Friday 10 May to 5am Monday 13 May**
(contingency date if rain work is cancelled due to rain the previous week)
- **8pm Friday 17 May to 5am Monday 20 May**
- **Friday 24 May to 5am Monday 27 May**
(contingency date if rain work is cancelled due to rain the previous week)

Our work schedule

During this period, we will be working 24 hours a day to complete this work to get the intersection back open as quickly as possible.

What will this mean for you?

The night work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, completing noisier work earlier in the evening and turning off vehicles when not in use.

Traffic Changes

To complete work at the intersection of St Martins Crescent and Prospect Highway, entry into and exit out of the intersection will be through a one-way contra flow. With motorists using one lane to travel in the opposite direction.

Traffic controllers will be in place to direct motorists between 8pm Friday 5 May to 5am Monday 6 May and 8pm Friday 10 May to 5am Monday 13 May (contingency) (weather permitting).

8pm Friday 17 May to 5am Monday 20 May and 8pm Friday 24 May to 5am Monday 27 May (contingency) (weather permitting).

Electronic message signs will be activated in both directions. Traffic control will be in place during work hours for the safety of workers and road users.

Motorists should follow signs and the traffic controller's direction and allow extra time as there may be minor delays.
