Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

We are replacing the ageing NSW regional rail fleet of XPT, XPLORER and Endeavour trains.

The new trains will provide new safety features, improved accessibility, facilities and reliability for customers who travel from many NSW regional centres to Sydney, as well as Canberra, Melbourne and Brisbane.

To accommodate the new fleet, some existing rail infrastructure will need to be modified at various locations across the rail network.

What work are we doing?

We will carry out investigation work at Stuart Town Station. This will include:

- establishment of a temporary site compound for the storage of plant and equipment and portable amenities
- surveying the station platform
- borehole drilling in multiple locations to determine ground conditions
- inspections of existing in-ground electrical pits
- assessing electrical infrastructure such as switchboards and existing light poles.

Equipment and machinery to be used but not limited to:

- laser scan for surveying
- mobile drill rig
- vacuum truck
- excavator
- front end loader
- hand tools.

When and where we'll be working

Work is scheduled to be carried out in February and March 2024 at Stuart Town Station, located off Railway Street. Work will take approximately three days and will be conducted during standard construction hours, from **7am** to **6pm** on:

- Thursday 29 February
- Tuesday 19 March
- Wednesday 20 March.

These dates are subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from construction activities.

Managing our impacts

We will take steps to reduce noise and impacts on the community and the environment.

This includes and is not limited to:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers
- instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum.
