


Redfern Station Upgrade

Upcoming work notification

April 2024

What's happening in April?

In April, our team we will:

- demobilise project site offices
- remove site offices, infrastructure and materials using cranes and trucks
- road marking on Lawson Street near Little Eveleigh Street.

Upcoming council work

From Tuesday 2 April, City of Sydney Council will install some traffic calming measures to the Wilson Street shared zone between Ivy Street and Little Eveleigh Street. This includes placement of sandstone blocks to slow vehicles and provide a safer area for pedestrians and cyclists.

When and where we'll work

Our standard construction hours are:

7am-6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am-6pm Saturday.

For the safety of our workers and the community, some work may take place outside the standard hours.

In April, this includes one night of work to conduct road marking on Lawson Street. Impacted residents will be notified in advance of the work starting.

What does this mean for you?

While the work is underway, you may notice:

- · workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- noise and vibration from machinery and equipment, such as cranes, grinders, jackhammers, power saws, rattle guns, rock hammers/breakers, rollers, excavators and trucks.

Wilson Street traffic and parking impacts

From 6am Monday 29 to 6pm Tuesday 30 April, up to six parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable. Please see the map overleaf for more information.

This will enable oversize vehicles to remove the site office infrastructure, equipment and materials.

Little Eveleigh shared zone

In April, it is anticipated that the Little Eveleigh Street shared zone will be opened to vehicle traffic.

The shared zone will open following road marking on Lawson Street.

Lawson Street crossing

In April, the new pedestrian crossing near the intersection of Lawson and Little Eveleigh Street will be temporarily removed.

At a later date, the crossing will be reinstated when additional street lighting is in place and the crossing can be adequately illuminated at night.

The removal will occur at night but is not expected to be noisy. Nearby residents will be notified before the night work takes place.

Managing our impacts

We reduce noise and vibration by turning off machinery when not in use and, where possible, use noise absorbing blankets.


Future work and communications
