What we're doing

Sydney Trains is carrying out improvement works on the east side of Railway Parade, Woodford from Saturday 18 May to Sunday 19 May.

To ensure the safety and reliability of train movements, we will be upgrading the storm water drainage system by installing a retaining wall & culvert within the rail corridor.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the weekdays. We apologise for the inconvenience this may cause.
- Work will take place from 5am Saturday 18 May to 10pm Sunday 19 May.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of plant & equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be accessing the site via Railway Parade rail corridor access gate.
- While we park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware there may be limited parking near the worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works. Traffic may be stopped for a short duration to allow vehicle access into and out of the site.
