Auburn to St Marys track maintenance

From Friday 26 April to Monday 29 April 2024

What we're doing

Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works between Auburn and St Marys from Friday 26 April to Monday 29 April.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport will undertake platform hoarding installation, concrete work, electrical disconnection and connection at St Marys during this time.

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Ballast cleaning between Pendle Hill and Seven Hills
- Bridge renewal at Bridge Road Overbridge, Westmead
- Contact wire renewal between Toongabbie and Seven Hills
- Culvert upgrade at Wentworthville
- Drainage maintenance at Clyde
- Rerailing at Blacktown
- Resignalling works between Auburn and Granville
- Resleepering, ballasting and bog hole removal between Toongabbie and Wentworthville
- Routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Station maintenance works, to improve safety on stations
- Track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Track reconditioning at Blacktown
- Track resurfacing, tamping and rail grinding activities
- Turnout refurbishment between Seven Hills and Blacktown
- Turnout resurfacing at Clyde and between St Marys and Blacktown
- Vegetation maintenance, litter and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- Work will take place from 11pm Friday 26 April to 2am Monday 29 April.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking
 may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
