## Macdonaldtown to Hornsby track maintenance

From Friday 12 April to Monday 15 April 2024

### What we're doing

Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works between Macdonaldtown and Hornsby from Friday 12 April to Monday 15 April.

Between Artarmon and Chatswood stations Sydney Metro will be undertaking fencing rectification and maintenance work.

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Bridge refurbishment works at Pacific Highway Overbridge, Hornsby
- Construction works between Wollstonecraft and St Leonards
- Cutting works at Pymble
- Drainage maintenance at various locations
- Platform building works at Lindfield Station
- Routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Wollstonecraft and Killara
- Sydney Harbour Bridge maintenance and upgrade works
- Track circuit upgrade works at City Underground stations
- Track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Track resurfacing, tamping and rail grinding activities
- Transmission line installation works between Gordon and Hornsby
- Turnout refurbishment at Hornsby
- Turnout renewal at Waverton and St Leonards
- Vegetation maintenance, litter, and graffiti removal.

### How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- **Work will take place from 11pm Friday 12 April to 3am Monday 15 April.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

#### Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
