

Pymble North railway embankment and drainage maintenance

From Saturday 13 April to Sunday 14 April

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking embankment stabilisation and drainage construction works along the railway cutting north of Pymble Station from Saturday 13th April to Sunday 14th April.

We are spraying concrete to cover the face of the railway embankment to reducing the risk of embankment slips as well as installing new drainage to ensure integrity of the track formation in order to minimise disruption of rail operations.

Please note all the required environmental approvals have been obtained and relevant environmental guidelines will be followed.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during weekends.
- **Weekend work will take place between 6am and 7pm on Saturday 13 April and Sunday 14 April.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Work vehicles and heavy vehicles will be using Avon Road to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be restricted near worksites.
