Sydney Harbour Bridge

From Friday 12 April to Monday 15 April 2024

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the timber deck supporting the track on the Sydney Harbour Bridge with a concrete composite deck. The work is being completed in stages during scheduled weeknight and weekend rail closedowns. The new deck will strengthen the structure, extend the life of the rail corridor, simplify track maintenance and, when complete, reduce train noise for nearby residents.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works will create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Works will take place from 10pm Friday 12 April to 5am Monday 15 April.
- Work activities include plant movement within the rail corridor from Blue Street Carpark to the north and from the southern approach of the Sydney Harbour Bridge. Blue Street will be used as the main access point for plant and materials during the work.
- Machinery will be used throughout the work, and we will select low-noise equipment when available.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- There will be a road closure on Cumberland Street and partial road closure on George Street under the Harbour Bridge from 12am Saturday 13 April to 6am Sunday 14 April.
- Work vehicles will use local streets to access the worksite.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking
 may be limited near worksite. Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout
 the duration of the works.
- From 6pm Friday 12 April to 5am Monday 15 April kerb side parking along Watson Road and Upper Fort Street between Argyle Street and the entrance to Fort Street Public School as well as parking along Argyle Street between Kent Street at Millers Point will be temporarily unavailable.

Sydney Harbour Bridge Road Lane closures

 Two north bound road lanes on the Sydney Harbour Bridge will be closed overnight on Friday 12 April and three north bound road lanes on the Sydney Harbour Bridge will be closed overnight on Saturday 13 April as the space will be required for safe delivery of plant and materials to the worksite.
