Sydenham to Sefton track maintenance

From Saturday 4 May to Monday 6 May 2024

What we're doing

Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works between Sydenham and Sefton via Bankstown from Saturday 4 May to Monday 6 May.

At Sydenham, Sydney Metro will be installing TV equipment and cabling, carrying out electrical fit out, testing and commissioning installed equipment and undertaking dynamic train testing.

Between Sydenham and Bankstown, Sydney Metro is delivering finishing work at all station platform buildings, undertaking visual inspections and utilities investigation work on rail overbridges, undertaking track adjustments, installing new overhead wire structures and making wiring adjustments, carrying out work on security and segregation fencing, building new trackside cabling and equipment, carrying out substation and power upgrade work and constructing the new metro platform at Bankstown.

Sydney Metro will also be installing CCTV equipment and cabling and carrying out testing and commissioning of installed equipment.

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Civil track maintenance
- Routine signal and electrical maintenance
- Station maintenance works, to improve safety on stations
- Track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Track resurfacing, tamping and grinding activities
- Turnout resurfacing between Bankstown and Sefton
- Vegetation maintenance, litter and graffiti removal

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- **Work will take place from 2am Saturday 4 May to 2am Monday 6 May.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
