Tuggerah Station Upgrade

May 2024

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Tuggerah Station

Transport for NSW is upgrading Tuggerah Station. The upgrade will provide a train station that is safe, inclusive and easy to use for all passengers - especially people with disability, older people, people with prams or luggage and others who might be experiencing mobility problems.

What we are doing in May 2024?

Work includes:

- completion of lift shafts and waterproofing
- building of lift stairs & landings on platforms
- installation of modules on bridge planks
- general construction works, including delivery and removal of plant and materials
- surveying and site investigations
- adjustments to hoarding and fencing to facilitate construction works
- formwork, reinforcement and concrete pours
- crane movements to assist with construction
- earthwork activities including waste classification and removal of waste materials
- relocation of lights, CCTV cameras and signs on both platforms
- completion of new structural supports under Platform 1
- installation of utility connections for the station
- demolition and excavation work and associated truck movements for import and export of materials.

Drivers will continue to see construction vehicle movements and traffic control on Pacific Highway and Anzac Road.

When we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Out of hours

From **10pm Friday 17 May to 7am Monday 20 May 2024**, additional plant movements will occur throughout the commuter car park during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running. Work will include delivery and installation of structural steel for the new station structure and the use of cranes, concrete trucks, heavy plant and powered hand tools.

What will this mean for you?

We will use various equipment, including cranes, excavators, jack hammers, trucks including tipper, flat tray track and hiab, elevated work platform, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, powered and manual hand tools.

Asbestos remediation work

As part of major construction work on the Tuggerah Station Upgrade, the project team will be removing and relocating asbestos-containing materials (ACM) from inside the project boundary between **Wednesday 1 May and Thursday 9 May 2024**.

The material that we are removing is bonded (non-friable) asbestos. It is a small amount of bonded asbestos that was uncovered during routine excavations. The area where the material



was found has been cordoned off and the material has been covered.

This work will be carried out during standard construction hours, weather permitting.

We have engaged a licensed local contractor to safely remove, relocate and dispose of the ACM and an experienced independent hygienist will be onsite at all times to supervise during the work.

This work will involve:

- workers in additional personal protective equipment (PPE) accessing site
- installing fencing and signage to mark exclusion zones
- using machinery to dig and load ACM into covered trucks
- undertaking sampling, testing and inspections
- air quality monitoring.

The safety of workers and the community is our highest priority and there are strict measures in place to minimise risks and reduce any potential harm.

All work will be carried out in line with the relevant legislation, SafeWork NSW codes of practice and the Transport for NSW (TfNSW) Asbestos Management Plan.

How is dust being managed during this work?

To minimise and contain dust during ACM work, we:

- dampen all surfaces regularly using a water cart
- protect exposed materials with covers and soil binder
- review weather forecasts and stopping work in strong winds.

How will the work affect you?

All work will take place inside the project boundary and this specific site area will be closed for all other construction activities until the ACM have been removed. Access to private property will be maintained at all times. Noise from machinery and vehicles is expected to be moderate and will be minimised where possible.

Remediation

A licensed asbestos removal subcontractor with the expertise and qualifications to safely and effectively remove asbestos-containing materials has been engaged.

All asbestos-containing materials removed from the construction site will be transported to a licensed asbestos waste facility for disposal.

Changes to parking in the Bryant Drive commuter carpark

During May, there will be continued temporary changes to car parking arrangements at Tuggerah Station to allow for construction work

We will be temporarily relocating seven parking spots and six accessible parking spots from the commuter car park on Bryant Drive intermittently until Tuesday 24th May 2024.

Additional accessible parking spots are available in the council car park on Bryant Drive. Signage is in place to direct drivers. The area will be utilised as a lay down area for structural steel that will be pre-assembled prior to being lifted into final position.

Schedules and work are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

Managing our impacts

A traffic control team will be available to assist with any impacts to pedestrian movements.

This work may be noisy, however we aim to avoid impacts to the community and the environment where possible by:

- fencing off areas for the safety of commuters
- using noise blankets and turning off machinery and equipment when not in use.
