What we're doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains is undertaking electrical maintenance work at Heathcote Substation (located on Princes Highway, Heathcote) from Monday 17 June to Friday 5 July.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your family. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from 6.30am to 3.30pm on weekdays from Monday 17 June to Friday 5 July.**
- **Work will also take place on the following weekends:**
 - **from 9pm Friday 21 June to 8pm Sunday 23 June**
 - **from 6am Saturday 29 June to 6pm Sunday 30 June**
- Equipment will be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment and materials.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the substation.
- While we will park our vehicles near the substation complex where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.
