Granville to Emu Plains track maintenance

From Friday 17 May to Monday 20 May 2024

What we're doing

Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works between Granville and Emu Plains from Friday 17 May to Monday 20 May.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport will undertake crane set up and removal, adjusting construction hoarding, asphaltting work areas and removal of materials from those areas, and electrical and piling work on all platforms. This work will be undertaken to prepare for the construction of the new footbridge in St Marys.

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Bridge renewal at Bridge Road Overbridge, Westmead
- Bridge renewal at Nepean River Underbridge, Emu Plains
- Culvert upgrade at Wentworthville
- Drainage maintenance at Westmead
- Overhead wiring modernisation works at Penrith Yard
- Rerailing between Blacktown, Seven Hills and Toongabbie
- Resignalling works at Penrith
- Routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Station maintenance works, to improve safety on stations
- Track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Track reconditioning at St Marys
- Track resurfacing, tamping and rail grinding activities
- Turnout resurfacing at between Blacktown and Werrington
- Vegetation maintenance, litter and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- **Work will take place from 11:15pm Friday 17 May to 2am Monday 20 May.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
