

2016/17 SYDNEY ANNUAL TAXI LICENCE DETERMINATION

Section 32C, Passenger Transport Act 1990

I, Timothy Peter Reardon, Secretary of the Department of Transport, on behalf of Transport for NSW hereby determine under section 32C(1) of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* as follows

The number of annual licences to be issued for taxi-cabs during the year commencing on 1 July 2016 is zero (0).

This determination applies to:

- A. Licences of unrestricted class.
- B. Licences of peak availability class.
- C. Licences of fringe area class.

This determination does not apply to licences for wheelchair accessible taxi-cabs (section 32C(7)).

Defined terms

In this Determination:

fringe area class means a licence that may operate wholly within a defined geographic area as specified in the licence details and in accordance with the licence conditions.

Metropolitan transport district has the same meaning as in the *Transport Administration Act 1988*.

peak availability class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only at times specified in the licence conditions.

unrestricted class means a licence that may operate wholly within the Metropolitan transport district only and has no other operating restrictions.

All other terms in this Determination have the meaning provided for in the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*.
