

November 2016 Fare Compliance Survey Results



Survey background

The fare compliance survey is conducted twice yearly in May and November, and is designed to measure the incidence of non-compliance and associated revenue loss across the public transport network. This work identifies problem areas and helps the NSW Government develop strategies to improve both fare compliance and public transport cost recovery.

The November 2016 survey was undertaken in an Opal-only ticketing environment for the first time. Over 70,000 Opal cards and Opal single trip tickets were inspected during the survey on train, bus, ferry and light rail.

Non-compliant customers included those not having a ticket or not tapping on (no ticket), those travelling on a Child/Youth Opal single trip ticket or Concession Opal card without valid entitlement (concession misuse), and those travelling beyond the distance they paid for (overriding).

Fare compliance and estimated revenue loss by mode

Revenue loss figures represent estimated revenue lost due to non-compliance for the six month periods.

- "Fare loss" includes fare-paying customers carrying an Opal card but not tapping on, and customers carrying no ticket at all.
- "No fare loss" includes Opal single trip tickets not tapped on and free groups not tapping on, such as school students.
