
Bankstown Station train timetable – a look at your station

The train timetable will provide customers using Bankstown station with:

- Four extra limited-stops services to Central every morning peak, resulting in less crowding and more seats available.
- Increased frequency total number of services increases by 63 each week.
- More regular and consistent services with a new easy-to-remember timetable – trains to the city run every 15 minutes in the morning peak.
- More reliable services thanks to the new \$102 million Homebush and Lidcombe

turnbacks, which separate Bankstown Line services from the South, Inner West and Western lines.

 More direct services for customers travelling to work in the CBD, with more City Circle services stopping first at larger stations Town Hall and Wynyard. Currently many Bankstown Line services travel around the City Circle anticlockwise, stopping at Museum, St James and Circular Quay before Wynyard and Town Hall.
