Blacktown Station Upgrade

APRIL - MAY 2017 - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure. The Blacktown Station Upgrade includes:

- A new pedestrian footbridge connecting the Richmond Line concourse with the main concourse
- A new lift and stairs connecting platform 3 with the new footbridge
- New stairs and weather protection canopies to platforms 1 and 2.

Upcoming construction activities

Over the coming months, you may notice the following activities:

- Installation of concrete foundations, steel structures and support structures for the new footbridge
- Installation of temporary bus layover bays in the bus interchange
- Civil works for new lift adjacent to platform 3

Night works – April & May 2017

To enable construction work for the Blacktown Station Upgrade to be undertaken safely and to minimise disruption to passengers and nearby residents, certain activities need to be undertaken at night. These night works may include piling on platforms 1/2, delivery and installation of scaffolding and timber frames on platform 4 and removal of sections of the concrete structures on the main concourse. These works will continue from **Monday to Friday between 6pm to 7am each day.**

Temporary loss of parking spaces

Approximately 25 parking spaces within the commuter car park adjacent to the bus interchange will be unavailable until the completion of the project in early 2018. This is for the provision of temporary bus layover bays to enable construction activities to progress safely. Signage has been installed to notify users and we apologise for any inconvenience.



Weekend work – Saturday 22 April to Sunday 23 April 2017

From 6am to 6pm Saturday 22 April and Sunday 23 April, works are planned during a Sydney Trains scheduled trackwork weekend where limited services are running (for enquiries regarding rail services during the weekend works, please contact the Transport Infoline on 131 500). Work activities will include installation of concrete foundations, steel structures and support structures for the new footbridge.

What equipment will be used?

The following equipment has been approved for use during construction:

- Power and hand tools
- Elevated work platforms
- Construction vehicles and plant
- Traffic control vehicles
- Vacuum truck

- Generator (including portable)
- Piling rig
- **Excavators**
- Crane and semi-trailers
- Concrete truck and pump

Some of the works may be noisy. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to commuters, nearby residents and businesses. Where required, signage will be installed and traffic controllers will be on site to facilitate safe pedestrian and vehicle movements.

Construction hours

All other work will be carried out during standard constructions hours, 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. The community will be notified of any works outside these hours prior to the works commencing. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your cooperation during these important works.
