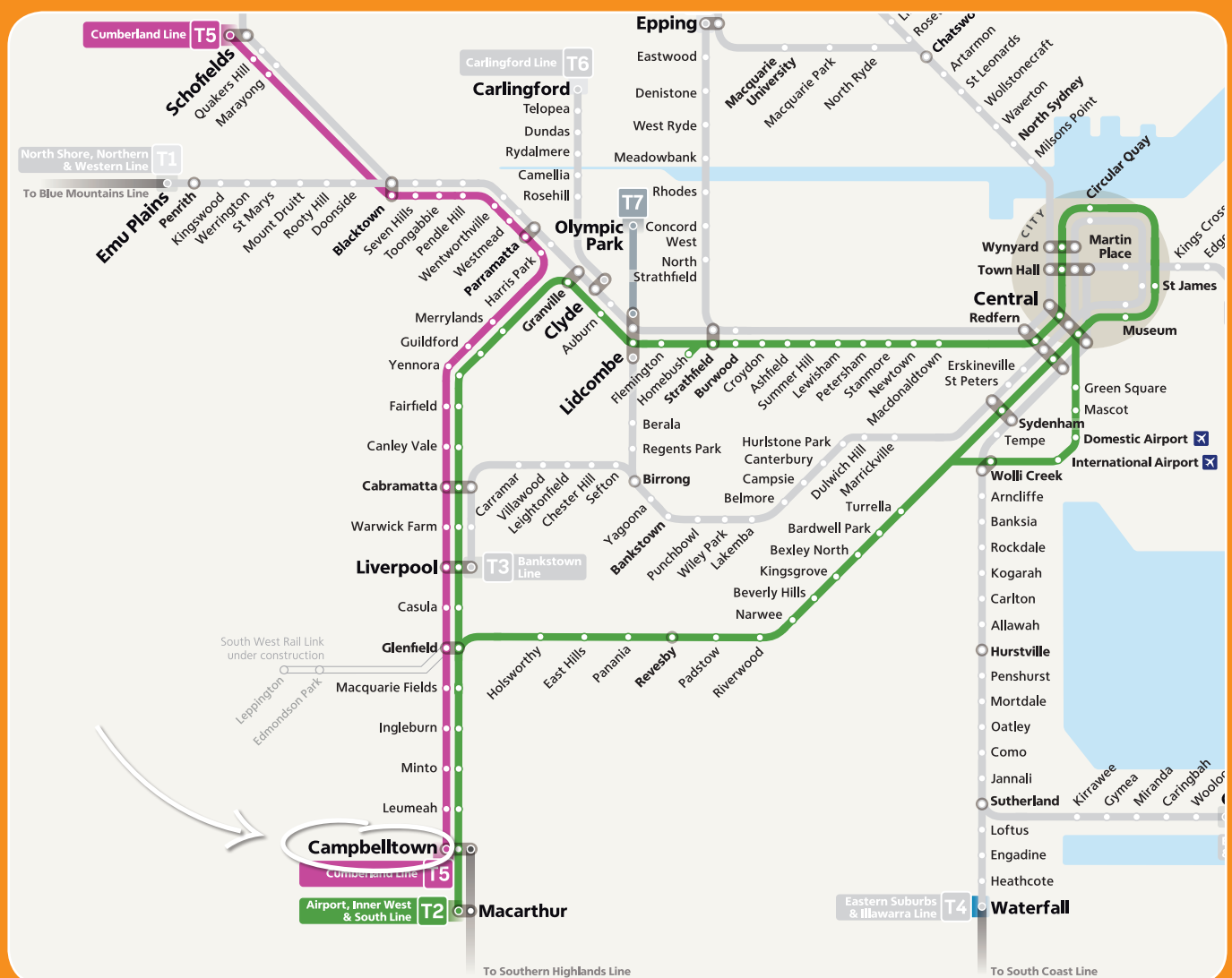


Campbelltown Station

train timetable – a look at your station

The train timetable will provide customers using Campbelltown station with:

- Reduced journey times to the city throughout the day, saving customers up to four minutes during the peak and up to 11 minutes during off-peak times.
- 35 new express services a week during peak periods travelling via the Airport and East Hills Line.
- Improved spacing of services in the morning peak, reducing wait times.
- Two services per hour weekdays 7am-7pm to and from Blacktown via Liverpool and Parramatta, linking centres of education and employment in Western Sydney.
- The new timetable makes use of the Kingsgrove to Revesby track quadruplication, which allows longer distance express services to operate on separate tracks and overtake all-stations services on the Airport & East Hills Line. This reduces journey times for longer-distance customers travelling to the city from Campbelltown and improves reliability by separating services.
