On 8 May 2015, the City of Sydney, in its capacity as a Roads Authority under section 51L of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*, notified the CSTTC of a proposal to widen the footway and install bicycle parking to improve access for both pedestrians and cyclists on Crown Street near Fitzroy Place.

A proposed resolution for endorsement was circulated on 20 May 2015 to CSTTC Members as out of session business in accordance with clause 15(1) of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

- Notes the particulars of the proposed works forwarded by City of Sydney.
- Notes the report of the CSTTC Working Group on the proposed works.
- Notes that the proposed works will improve pedestrian safety and cyclist amenity.
- Notes that the City has responded to issues raised by RMS and TfNSW to the previous CSTTC item relating to this issue (Item 2015/03).
- Notes that the City will implement an 11m loading zone within close proximity
 to the subject site, subject to consultation with the community and
 endorsement by the Local Pedestrian, Cycling and Traffic Calming
 Committee, as per standard procedure.
- **Resolves** not to issue any direction to the City of Sydney pursuant to section 51L of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

Pursuant to clause 15(1) of Schedule 2 of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*, the resolution was carried by the majority of the Members on 1 June 2015.
