

Central Sydney Traffic and Transport Committee (CSTTC)

Resolution in Relation to Out of Session Business Item 2014/11

On 7 October 2014, the City of Sydney, in its capacity as a Parking Authority under section 51M of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*, notified the CSTTC of a proposal relating to the installation of ticket parking in Corben, Fitzroy and Little Riley Streets in Surry Hills.

A proposed resolution for endorsement was circulated on 10 October 2014 to CSTTC Members as out of session business in accordance with clause 15(1) of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

Resolved

The CSTTC:

- **Notes** the particulars of the proposed scheme forwarded by City of Sydney.
- **Notes** the report of the CSTTC Working Group on the proposed scheme.
- **Notes** that the proposed scheme will not have a significant impact on traffic, transport or parking in the CBD.
- **Agrees** pursuant to section 51M(1) of the *City of Sydney Act 1988* to 14 days as the lesser period within which particulars of the proposed scheme are required to be forwarded to the CSTTC before the proposed commencement of the scheme.
- **Resolves** not to issue any direction to the City of Sydney pursuant to section 51M of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

Pursuant to clause 15(1) of Schedule 2 of the *City of Sydney Act 1988* the resolution was carried by the majority of the Members on 20 October 2014.
