

Central Sydney Traffic and Transport Committee (CSTTC)

Resolution in Relation to Out of Session Business Item 2016/02

On 13 May 2016, the City of Sydney, in its capacity as a Roads Authority under section 51L of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*, notified the CSTTC of a proposal to permanently close Barrack Street to motor vehicle access between York Street and George Street and designate Barrack Street for pedestrian and bicycle access only.

A proposed resolution for endorsement was circulated on 2 June 2016 to CSTTC Members as out of session business in accordance with clause 15(1) of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

Resolved

The CSTTC:

- **Notes** the particulars of the proposed permanent road closure forwarded by City of Sydney.
- **Notes** the report of the CSTTC Working Group on the proposed permanent road closure.
- **Notes** the proposal will improve pedestrian and bicycle safety and access as well as street activation and, and is necessary for CBD and South East Light Rail operations.
- **Resolves** not to issue any direction to the City of Sydney pursuant to section 51L of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

Pursuant to clause 15(1) of Schedule 2 of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*, the resolution was carried by the majority of the Members on 10 June 2016.
