New train timetable Starts 20 October

The NSW Government will implement a new timetable on Sunday 20 October 2013. It's a major rewrite of the timetable and has been designed to improve the customer experience by delivering:

- More than 1000 extra weekly services.
- More than 600 new weekly express services.
- 230 extra peak services to and from the city each week.
- 20,000 extra seats to the city every weekday morning.
- A further 182 extra train services each week running between Redfern and the City Circle, providing additional capacity in the CBD.
- Makes the best use of hundreds of millions of dollars of investment in rail infrastructure and new rolling stock including more than 50 new air-conditioned Waratah trains.
- Faster journeys for customers travelling longer distances.
- Better connections with buses and ferries.
- Frequent turn-up-and-go or clock-face services from many stations.
- Regular departure times so many customers won't need a timetable.
- Fewer stopping patterns, making the timetable easier for customers to understand.
