

## **Central Sydney Traffic and Transport Committee (CSTTC)**

### **Resolution in Relation to Out of Session Business Item 2013/29**

On 30 October 2013, the City of Sydney, in its capacity as a Roads Authority under section 51L of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*, notified the CSTTC of a proposal to carry out works at Wilmot Street and Central Street as part of the CBD Laneways Revitalisation Strategy. These works aim to enhance these streets' role as pedestrian links and encourage activation. The proposed works include changes to traffic and parking, installation of traffic calming devices and improvements to pedestrian amenity.

The City of Sydney clarified the following with regard to their submission proposal:

- Kerb blisters on the eastern and western side of Pitt Street - are not part of the submission proposal. If City of Sydney was to pursue these it would be a separate application and process.
- The intersection of George Street/Central Street. The intersection and traffic light design will need to be separately agreed between Transport for NSW and Roads and Maritime Services with the City of Sydney.
- 20m of Central Street east of its intersection with George Street. This will be undertaken through a separate agreement with Transport for NSW.

A proposed resolution for endorsement was circulated on 12 November 2013 to CSTTC Members as out of session business in accordance with clause 15(1) of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

#### **Resolved**

The CSTTC:

- **Notes** the particulars of the proposed works forwarded by the City of Sydney.
- **Notes** the report of the CSTTC Working Group on the proposed works.
- **Notes** the proposed works would provide improved pedestrian amenity, connectivity and safety and encourage laneway activation.
- **Agrees** pursuant to section 51L(1) of the *City of Sydney Act 1988* to 21 days as the lesser period within which particulars of the proposed scheme are required to be forwarded to the CSTTC before the proposed commencement of the scheme.
- **Resolves** not to issue any direction to the City of Sydney pursuant to section 51L of the *City of Sydney Act 1988*.

Pursuant to clause 15(1) of Schedule 2 of the *City of Sydney Act 1988* the resolution was carried by the majority of the Members on 20 November 2013.
