The NSW Government will implement a new timetable on 20 October 2013. It's a major rewrite of the timetable and has been designed to improve the customer experience.

The new timetable will deliver more services, improve connections between different modes of public transport and reduce many journey times.

The timetable will also be easier for customers to use, with fewer stopping patterns and more consistent service times, particularly in peak periods.

Customers who travel longer distances from regional areas will notice fewer stops and reduced journey times in many instances.

Customers closer to the CBD will receive frequent, more evenly spaced services, with many stations receiving 'turn up and go' services.

A look at the line - morning peak



services operating through to the city in the AM peak, two to Martin Place and nine to Bondi Junction.

Up to 40 minute journey time savings a week from Wollongong to the city and back during the busiest peak periods, with typical savings of 5-6 minutes for trips during the day.

Typical journey time savings of up to six minutes on trips from Thirroul to the city between the peak periods.

Up to 65 minute journey time savings a week from Kiama to the city and back during the busiest peak periods.

* Typical weekly journey from Wollongong to city and return, arriving Central between 8am and 8.59am and departing 5pm to 5.59pm.

† Typical weekly journey from Kiama to city and return, arriving Central between 8am and 8.59am and departing 5pm to 5.59pm.

AM peak = trains arrive at Central between 6am and 10am, Monday to Friday.
PM peak = trains depart Central between 3pm and 7pm, Monday to Friday.
Busiest peak periods 8-8.59am and 5-5.59pm Monday-Friday.

The train timetable will provide customers using the South Coast Line with:

- Significantly improved journey times from major stations, including Kiama, Wollongong and North Wollongong.
- 125 new express services each week.
- Every train now stops at Wolli Creek, making it easier for South Coast customers to catch a train to Sydney Airport's domestic and international terminals.
- An extension of the local service between Port Kembla and Thirroul to Waterfall, providing improved connections between local centres and schools with an hourly service, and connecting customers at northern stations such as Austinmer and Coledale with intercity services at Helensburgh and suburban services at Waterfall.
