# Transport Access Program

## Toongabbie Station Upgrade

**COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION**

**JULY / AUGUST 2017**

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

The Toongabbie Station Upgrade will provide customers with new lifts, stairs, platform canopies, new family accessible toilets, improved bicycle facilities, lighting, and wayfinding signage.

### Project update

Works are progressing well at Toongabbie Station with piling and excavation for two lift shafts and installation of hoarding on the platforms now complete. Implementation of traffic and pedestrian management on Wentworth Avenue and Portico Parade will continue to ensure the safety of commuters and traffic around the station.

In July, **tiling works will be commencing on the footbridge**. This work will be completed in stages to minimise the impact on pedestrians and keep the footbridge open.

The footbridge will become narrower during this period and we ask pedestrians to please be considerate and to take extra care when moving over the footbridge during these works. Tiling works will continue for up to 16 weeks.

### Upcoming out of hours works

**From 10pm Friday 4 August to 6am Monday 7 August 2017**

Work has been planned dur this weekend as part of a scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown to provide safe access for workers and minimise disruption to rail users. Activities over the weekend include:

- installation of lift shafts, platform canopy footings and canopy steel
- lowering of over-head wires
- main sewer connection works.

A crane will be established and operating on Portico Parade. **Portico Parade will be CLOSED from Toongabbie Road to Cornelia Road, with residents only access.** Traffic control will be implemented to allow safe access for residents and to direct traffic around the detour. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Businesses will operate as usual.

**Toongabbie station footbridge will remain OPEN to pedestrians. Buses will replace trains from the bus stop located on Wentworth Avenue (before Barangaroo Road).** Traffic controllers will be present to assist pedestrians, and to direct commuters to train replacement buses. **Please see map below for the location of train replacement buses and traffic detours.**

## 9pm to 6am Nightly from Monday 7 August to Friday 10 August 2017

Work will be taking place within the railway corridor. Activities occurring nightly will include:

- installation of roofing to lifts
- movement of materials between platforms
- traffic controllers on Portico parade directing work vehicles safely in and out of site.

## From 10pm Friday 11 August to 6am Monday 14 August 2017

Work has also been planned for a second scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown.

Activities over the weekend include:

- continued installation of lifts shafts
- platform canopy steel
- installation of anti-throw screens.

A crane will be established and operating on Wentworth Avenue. **Wentworth Avenue will be CLOSED from Barangaroo Road to the roundabout on Wentworth Avenue, with residents only access.** Workers will be on platforms 1 and 2.

Traffic control will be implemented to allow safe access for residents and to direct traffic around the detour. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Businesses will operate as usual.

**Toongabbie station footbridge will remain OPEN to pedestrians, as trains will still be running from platforms 2 and 3.** Traffic control will be implemented to ensure safe movement of pedestrians and traffic around the area. **Please contact 131 500 for timetable information.**

Equipment to be used throughout this period will include a crane, excavator, bobcat, compactors, generators, vacuum truck, and various hand tools. This work will be noisy at times. Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents.



## Standard construction hours

All other construction on the station upgrade will be undertaken during standard working hours, which are

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and
- 8am to 1pm Saturday

Notification of any other works occurring outside these standard hours will be given prior to works commencing.
