



Wynyard Station construction will be taking place from 1 August 2017

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we are upgrading Wynyard Station to provide increased customer capacity and an improved gateway to Barangaroo and Sydney's financial district.

What we're doing at Wynyard

Between 1 August and 31 August 2017, work to refurbish the York Street lobby and upgrade the escalators and platforms will continue.

Tuesday 1 August to Thursday 31 August

Day works: 7am to 6pm Monday to Sunday

Night works: 7pm to 6am Monday to Sunday

Work taking place during this period includes:

- Installation of the York Street escalators. Work includes installing escalator components, services, fixtures and fittings, such as steel work and acoustic panels, and painting work.
- Fit out of the York Street lobby.
- Work to upgrade power supply services to the station and installation of the main switchboard components.
- Installing fixtures and finishes on platforms including lighting.
- Work to install the heat relief system on the station platforms.
- Reinstatement of the road surface in York Lane.

How will this work affect you?

Works in York lane

Work will continue to reinstate the road surface as well as the installation of mini awning in York Lane during standard working hours.

Standard working hours will be 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 7am to 3pm Saturday.

Vehicle access along York Lane will remain closed but pedestrian access to York Lane from the Clarence Street entrance (at Wynyard) will be maintained, where possible.

Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and road users.

The City of Sydney will be carrying out this work on our behalf. Crane operations on York Street

On Sunday 6 August and Sunday 13 August between 10pm and 5am we will be installing a crane on York Street to lift materials out of the site from Wynyard Park. The crane would partially occupy the bus lane adjacent to Wynyard Park only. Temporary stoppages may occur on York Street throughout this activity.

Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and road users

Pedestrian changes

Access to the station via the York Street entrance will remain temporarily closed. Access along the footpath on York Street will be maintained.

Work will continue behind the hoarding and temporary fencing 24 hours per day, seven days a week. Parts of the concourse and platforms will be temporarily affected while work is completed.

Traffic changes

Deliveries to and from site may occur via Cumberland Street, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Subject to approval, deliveries may also be made via George Street


and York Street between 10pm and 5am, Monday to Sunday.

Large and oversize deliveries at night via York Street may require a partial road closure of the southbound traffic lanes. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and road users.

Noise and dust

You may experience some noise during this work which may include drilling, hammering and use of hand tools during construction hours. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to residents and businesses while work takes place.

Where required, any dust generating activities will be watered down and vehicles will be switched off when not in use to minimise noise.
