

Abbotsford Wharf Upgrade

Temporary wharf closure for upgrade from Wednesday 7 February

29 January 2018

The NSW Government is upgrading Abbotsford Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program.

As notified in the December Community Update, Abbotsford Wharf will be closed for upgrade from **Wednesday 7 February** for about four months, weather and maritime conditions permitting. All efforts will be made to reopen the wharf as soon as possible.

A temporary construction site compound will be established near the wharf for the duration of the project. The area will be fenced off and restricted to authorised personnel and visitors.

The standard work hours will be between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm Saturday. Some early morning and night work will be needed to install piles and lift sections of the wharf in place, when the water is at its calmest. Some of this work will generate noise. We will notify nearby residents and businesses prior to any early morning or night work taking place.

Alternative transport during construction

During the upgrade of Abbotsford Wharf, customers will be able to catch a temporary bus service, route 437, operating between Abbotsford Wharf and Chiswick shopping centre, with a four minute walk to Chiswick Wharf to connect with F3 Parramatta River services. The temporary bus service will stop at all stops along Great North Road and Blackwall Point Road between Abbotsford Wharf and Chiswick shopping centre.

During the temporary closure of Abbotsford Wharf, limited stop peak hour ferry services currently serving Abbotsford will stop at Chiswick Wharf.. Customers should check timetable and trip planning options when planning their trip. Ferry services to other wharves will not be affected.

Customers travelling to or from the city can also catch existing bus service 438 / L38 from Abbotsford to Martin Place or the 504 / X04 bus service from the corner of Great North Road to the Queen Victoria Building.
