

Abbotsford Wharf upgrade

The upgraded wharf is designed to provide customers with an improved public transport experience.

The new wharf will incorporate a floating pontoon connected to an entry shelter by a covered gangway.

The pontoon will have a curved roof which will shelter customers from the weather. Glass weather protection panels and new seating will provide improved comfort. The new gangway, entry and bridge will be covered.

The new wharf will look similar to wharves at Chiswick and Meadowbank which have also been upgraded as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program.

Proposed landside upgrades include a new Kiss and Ride zone, bicycle rack and wayfinding signage. New handrails and tactile indicators will be installed on the stairs leading from Werrell Reserve.
