

Night work on the East West Link and Croome Road, Albion Park Rail

Roads and Maritime Services is building a 9.8 kilometre extension of the M1 Princes Motorway between Yallah and Oak Flats to bypass Albion Park Rail.

Night work is required to progress construction of the bypass.

What are we doing?

We will be carrying out essential night work on the East West Link and Croome Road which involves the placement of safety barriers.

Work is required outside normal project hours for the safety of workers and road users and to minimise traffic delays.

We will be working between **7pm and 6am from Monday 29 April** for up to five nights, weather permitting.

What you need to know

We will make every effort to minimise disruption including noise and light by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

For the safety of motorists and our workers traffic changes will be in place and may affect travel times by up to five minutes. These include:

- partial lane closures and stop/slow traffic control
- a reduced 40km/h speed limit

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
