



Access changes – Croom Regional Sporting Complex

Work is progressing on the Albion Park Rail bypass, with construction expected to be complete in 2022, weather permitting.

As part of the work taking place inside the Croom Regional Sporting Complex, there will be some temporary changes to how you will access the facilities. These changes will be in place from **Monday 1 July 2019** for up to **three months**, weather permitting.

Managing the safety of our workers and the public is critically important to the project team. Full closures of some access roads within the sporting complex will be required while work is taking place.

Construction will generally be carried out during standard hours between **7am and 7pm on weekdays and 8am to 5pm on Saturdays**, weather permitting.

How will this work affect you?

Over the next three months, access to the northern fields including Illawarra Model Car Club, Southlake BMX Club, little athletics field and the senior rugby league field will be from Croome Road, near Cedar Street, Albion Park Rail.

Access to the southern fields including hockey, netball and junior rugby league fields and Shellharbour City Stadium will be from a new gate south of the Croome Road and the East West Link roundabout.
