Night work at the intersection of Woollybutt Drive, Nehme Avenue and Princes Highway, Albion Park Rail

We will be carrying out essential night work to identify services at the intersection of Woollybutt Drive, Nehme Avenue and Princes Highway, Albion Park Rail.

Work is required outside normal project hours for the safety of road users and workers and to avoid extended traffic delays during the day.

We will be working between 7pm and 7am from Sunday 28 July for up to 10 nights over a two week period, weather permitting.

There may be some noise associated with this work and we will make every effort to minimise disruption by scheduling noisier activities earlier in the night, and positioning equipment and lighting away from properties where possible. Residents will have access to their driveways at all times.

For the safety of road users and our workers, traffic control will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe.

This may include partial lane closures, temporary detours, stop/slow traffic conditions and a reduced speed of 40km/h.
