

Temporary traffic changes on Yallah Rd, Yallah from Sunday 8 September

As part of construction activities taking place for the Albion Park Rail bypass, there will be some temporary traffic changes in place on Yallah Road.

What are we doing?

In order to complete important utility relocation work on the existing Yallah Road, traffic will temporarily shift onto the new Yallah Road which is currently being built as part of the bypass.

This temporary traffic arrangement will be in place from **Sunday 8 September** and will remain in place for up to **eight weeks**, **weather permitting**

Traffic will then be switched back onto the existing Yallah Road to allow work to be completed on the new road.

Pedestrian access will be maintained via a footpath on the western side of the new Yallah Road and cyclists are advised to travel on the new Yallah Road during this temporary arrangement.

Other impacts

During this time, there will be increased activity around the work area on the new Yallah Road including the presence of workers, vehicles and equipment.

We will make every effort to keep disruptions to a minimum for motorists, residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site. Traffic control and reduced speed limits will be in place for the safety of motorists and workers during work.

We appreciate your patience during construction of the bypass and will continue to update you as work progresses.


