

Albion Park Rail bypass – temporary closure of Croome Road for foundation and pavement repairs

What are we doing?

Foundation and pavement repairs will be carried out on a section of Croome Road.

There will be a temporary closure of Croome Road between Grevillea Street and the East West Link from **7 April 2021**, weather permitting.

The closure and detour of Croome Road will be in place for about six weeks, weather permitting.

During the work, we will be removing a section of the existing road and shared path in order to carry out repairs to the underlying foundation and pavement.

Once this work is complete, Croome Road will be re-opened for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.

Why will the closure be in place for six weeks?

To reduce impacts to residents and motorists, we explored a number of options to complete this work. A six week temporary closure allows us to complete the work in the safest and most efficient way.

How will the work impact me?

During the work, there will be increased activity in the area including more workers, vehicles and equipment. We will make every effort to keep disruptions to a minimum for motorists, residents and businesses.

Most of this work is planned during our standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents in advance if work is required outside of these hours.

Traffic changes

Detours during the closure will be via the East West Link and Ashburton Drive or the Princes Highway and Tongarra Road. Motorists should allow extra travel time. Please see the detour map included for more information.

Detour signage will direct pedestrians and cyclists around the closure via the Croom Regional Sporting Complex shared path. Grevillea Street will remain open to traffic at all times.
