

Traffic changes on Yallah Road, Yallah from Saturday 14 December

We will be opening the newly completed Yallah Road in mid-December. To minimise impact to motorists and residents, work to complete this traffic change will be carried out during a weekend closure of Yallah Road from **7am Saturday 14 December to 5am Monday 16 December**.

What are we doing?

We will be closing Yallah Road to complete finishing work on the new Yallah Road from Saturday 14 December ahead of the road's permanent re-opening. We expect motorists to be driving on the new Yallah Road from Monday 16 December, weather permitting.

A weekend closure of Yallah Road will be in place from **7am Saturday 14 December to 5am Monday 16 December**.

A detour via Marshall Mount Road will be in place during this closure. Motorists are advised to add an additional 10 minutes to their journey.

Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained during this closure via the eastbound lane on the existing Yallah Road.

Other impacts

During this time, there will be increased activity around the work area including the presence of workers, vehicles and equipment.

We will make every effort to keep disruptions to a minimum for motorists, residents and businesses close to the project site. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, and follow the directions of signs and traffic control at all times.
