

Out of hours work on the Illawarra Highway at Albion Park Rail

We will carry out essential night work on the Illawarra Highway as part of the Albion Park Rail bypass over the next month.

What are we doing?

For the safety of motorists and workers, we will be constructing new road pavement surfaces on the Illawarra Highway during night shifts. Work will include trenching, saw cutting, excavating, laying road pavement, backfilling and reinstating ground surfaces.

Work will be carried out for around **10 nights** over a **four week period** from **Monday 2 March** between **7pm** and **7am**, weather permitting.

Electronic signs on the highway will advertise specific dates and detour information in advance.

We will make every effort to minimise impacts to residents by scheduling noisier activities earlier in the night, using noise shields where possible and positioning equipment away from properties where possible.

Traffic impacts

Some of this work will be carried out during the day, resulting in single lane closures, stop/slow traffic conditions and a reduced speed of 40km/hr. Some of this work may require closure of the Illawarra Highway at night. During full closures, motorists will be detoured via the Princes Highway and Tongarra Road.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions, and follow the directions of detour signs and traffic control.


