

Night work on Tongarra Road, Albion Park

Work is progressing on the Albion Park Rail bypass, with construction expected to be complete in 2022.

What are we doing?

We will be carrying out essential night work for utility relocation on Tongarra Road, Albion Park in December.

Work is required outside normal project hours for the safety of workers and road users and to coincide with a planned communication network outage.

There will be one night shift between **Monday 2 December and Wednesday 4 December**, weather permitting. This work will be carried out between 7pm and 7am.

Electronic signs will advertise specific dates in advance.

What can I expect?

There may be some noise associated with this work and we will make every effort to minimise disruption by using noise shields, arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Properties impacted by the planned outage will be notified separately by the service provider.
