

Night work during July on the Princes Highway for the Albion Park Rail bypass

As part of work on the Albion Park Rail bypass, directional signage will be installed on the Princes Highway near the Oak Flats interchange.

What are we doing?

We will be carrying out essential night work to install road signage and supporting structures.

We will be working for up to six nights between Monday 5 and Friday 16 July between 7pm and 7am, weather permitting.

There may be some noise and lighting associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise disruption by using noise shields and by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. Where possible, we will schedule noisier activities earlier in the night and position lighting towers away from properties.

Traffic changes

Traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users, including temporary road and lane closures, intermittent stop/slow traffic conditions, and a reduced speed of 40km/h during work.
